An interest-free loan is available to parents/guardians living in Koshigaya with financial difficulty in paying school admission expenses for their child who will enter high school, college, etc., in April 2024. (Application can be made before the announcement of the entrance exams result.)

How much (Limits of Loan): High school: Up to \(\frac{\pmax}{500,000}\) / College: Up to \(\frac{\pmax}{800,000}\)

\*Repayment amount should be paid within 5 years through annual or bi-annual installments.

#### Get to know the characteristics of flood disaster in Koshigaya!

Koshigaya is a flat terrain, which is greatly affected by heavy rain. Due to its geographical traits, water cannot be drained easily and it accumulates in the area, causing flooding. Since typhoon and rainy season is coming soon, prepare enough in advance.

#### **Key point!**

- 1. Confirm when to evacuate and what to do to protect yourself in an emergency situation.
- 2. Make a contingency plan in advance to evacuate safely. Think about life-saving actions.
- 3. Prepare necessary items such as food and a portable toilet.

This corner introduces people involved and who support the promotion of multicultural coexistence projects in Koshigaya.

This month, Ogawa Mitsuru-san will share his experiences. He started "Tabunka Kodomo Gakushu Juku" while working as a teacher of Koshigaya High School and has continued to support children with foreign roots even after retiring in 2012.

Hello, everyone! My name is Mitsuru Ogawa.

"Tabunka Kodomo Gakushu Juku" started in 2006, and over 300 children have come to study there so far.

In 2003, the first "High School Entrance Guidance" for foreign nationals was held in Saitama Prefecture. Since foreign students and their parents were not well-informed about the high school entrance exams, staff of Japanese language classes took the initiative to start the guidance.

Currently, there are annual guidance sessions held in seven locations within the prefecture.

In the eastern district, they have been mostly conducted in Koshigaya. However, since there are limited things to do in just an annual guidance session, we started the "Tabunka Kodomo Gakushu Juku" to provide Japanese language and study support for children with foreign roots. Yet, offering assistance only on the first and third Saturdays of the month were not sufficient. Still, we hoped it could become a place where they felt they belonged. A few years later, an acquaintance of mine who used to work as a teacher opened "Tabunka Kodomo Gakushu Juku" in Soka City on the second and fourth Saturdays of the month.

While the focus is on children, we also teach their parents Japanese. Most classes are conducted one-on-one, becoming opportunities for mutual learning. We look forward to your continued support.
