

Hello, everyone! My name is Ka. I work as a teacher at a municipal elementary school, and I also give presentations introducing China at the elementary school in Koshigaya as a part of international exchange.

20 years have passed since I came to Japan. When I first came here, I didn't know any Japanese phrases other than "ohayogozaimasu" and "yoroshikuonegaisimasu", which was so inconvenient.

The school teachers couldn't speak Chinese. They taught me Japanese with gestures, but I struggled in improving my Japanese skills. However, after I started to work part time as a side job in Japan, my ability to understand spoken Japanese has improved rapidly. And through using Japanese in daily conversations every day, I naturally became able to speak Japanese as well. Some of them corrected my incorrect Japanese use. And I realized that language skill cannot be acquired without using it.

Living in a foreign country, language barriers can feel like significant obstacles. Yet, with courage to take the first step, breaking down those barriers might surprisingly be easier than expected.

Everyone, let's actively communicate with various people in different places. Your Japanese skills will surely improve quickly. This will make your life in Japan more enjoyable. So, do your best! I'm cheering for you.
