

Special Cash Benefit Available for Households amid Increased Cost of Living

Target: Registered citizens of Koshigaya City as of December 1, 2023 that fall under any of the two categories

- 1. Municipal/Prefectural Tax exempt households for FY 2023
- 2. Households that experienced a sudden decrease in income and whose situation is equivalent to that of the Municipal/Prefectural Tax exempt households

Amount of Benefit: 70,000 yen per household

Application: Submit the required documents at the Special Cash Benefit Office (in the 3rd Building of the City Office, 4F) during the period as shown below.

- ► January 9 to March 29 for those who fall under the category 1
- ▶ January 15 to March 29 for those who fall under the category 2.

Exemption for National Health Insurance Tax Before and After Childbirth

Target:

Those enrolled in the National Health Insurance System who are pregnant; or gave birth after 85 days of pregnancy

Exemption Period:

From the month before the maternity due date to two months after childbirth.

Exemption Amount:

Up to 4-months payment for National Health Insurance Tax

*Up to 6-months payment for National Health Insurance Tax for those with multiple pregnancy or births **Application:** Submit applications to the counter of the National Health Insurance and Pension Section.

What to Bring:

·Mother and Child Health Handbook

•Copy of Birth Notification (Birth Certification, etc.)

National Health Insurance Card

·Documents showing Individual Number of the head of the household

• ID of the applicant

* Participation is free of charge. Application is not required.


*There is no parking space available for cars at the drill site.

Jó napot kívánok! (Hello! in Hungarian)

My name is Gabriella Imashima. I'm from Hungary. I moved to Japan in 2010, so it's been 13 years in Japan already. My husband is Japanese, and we have 2 children.

At the beginning it was shocking to experience the high population density on the trains and streets of Tokyo. Hungary's population is about the same as Tokyo city's; so when I go back to my country, walking in the streets of Budapest feels like walking in a small town.

It was very helpful to attend Japanese classes in Koshigaya city, both in the civic hall, and later in Bunkyo University. Especially, I could meet with a lot of friends from different countries. That's one of my greatest experiences in Japan. I also enjoyed giving introductory lectures of Hungary, in elementary schools and a few times junior high schools. It was funny to explore some similarities in our languages: for example "soba" means "room" in Hungarian, or "kirai" means "king", "usoda" means "swimming pool".

I am amazed how Japanese people learn and memorize those plenty of kanjis. I can write a few, read a little more. I think learning to speak Japanese is the first and most important. If we can communicate with the people around us, that makes us feel more comfortable and confident.
