About the Comprehensive Development Plan

Structure of the Plan

The 5th Koshigaya City Comprehensive Development Plan is the highest level document for all policies and projects Koshigaya City implements. This plan comprises three layers: “Basic Concept”, “Basic Plan”, and “Implementation Plan” so as to make it comprehensible for residents and adjustable to changes in social conditions.

Basic Concept

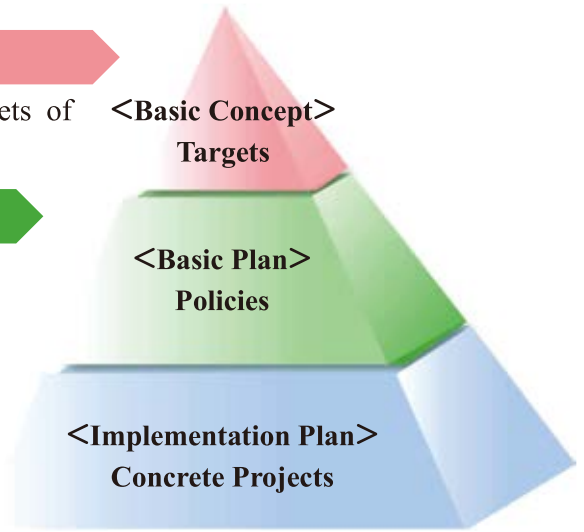
specifies vision of the future and development targets of Koshigaya City.

systematizes policies and specifies measures to realize vision of the future.

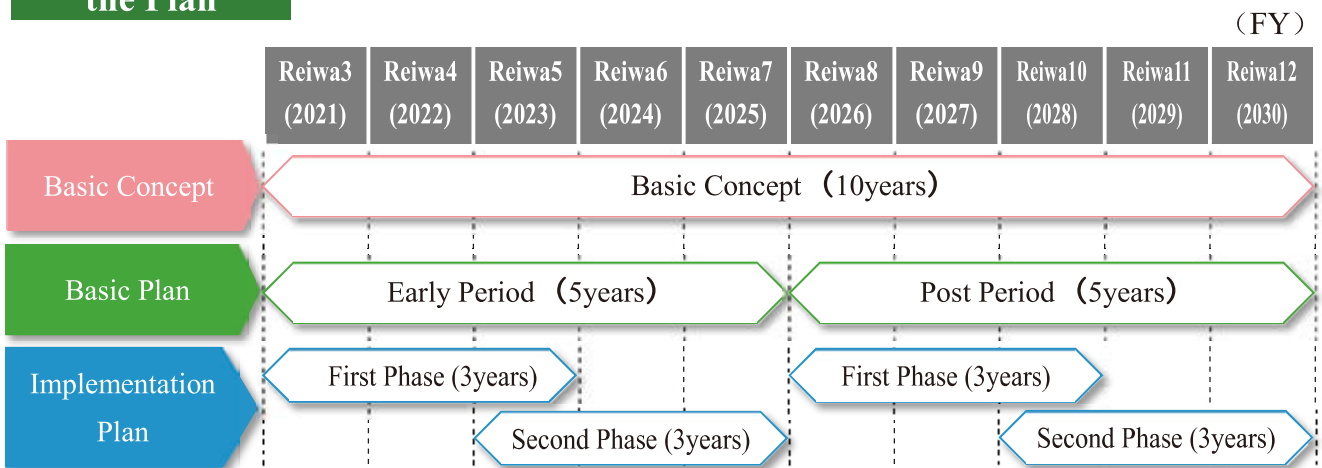
Implementation Plan

Time Period of the Plan

The time period of this plan is from FY2021 to FY2030.



Features of the plan

① Creating the plan with public participation

This plan was created through “participation” and “collaboration”, the principles listed on Koshigaya City Basic Ordinance by means of public participation which includes district development meetings, resident meetings, and youth meetings as well as questionnaires which targeted residents, organizations and companies.

② Promotion of the plan along with the comprehensive strategies

To keep achieving a vibrant city for many years to come, this plan is promoted along with “Community, People, and Employment Creation: Koshigaya City Comprehensive Strategy”

③ A plan based on the idea of SDGs

Understanding the principles of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): solving a wide range of economic, social, and environmental issues as well as achieving a common goal of global society with a pledge to Leave No One Behind, this plan promotes sustainable city development to cooperatively solve community issues.

Future Images of Koshigaya City

The City systematically promotes the city development based on 2 major trends: “the flow of a society with a declining population” and “the flow of times in a global society”, while keeping 6 social trends in mind.

Basic Philosophy of City Development

The formulation of this plan is based on “Koshigaya City Basic Ordinance”. This ordinance has the basic philosophy of “respect for human dignity” and “citizen sovereignty.” It presupposes residents and the city are to work for city development with foundation that every resident is respected as human beings and plays roles for city development. In addition, to promote city development based on the basic philosophy, this plan classifies “participation”, “collaboration” and “sharing information” as the three basic principles.

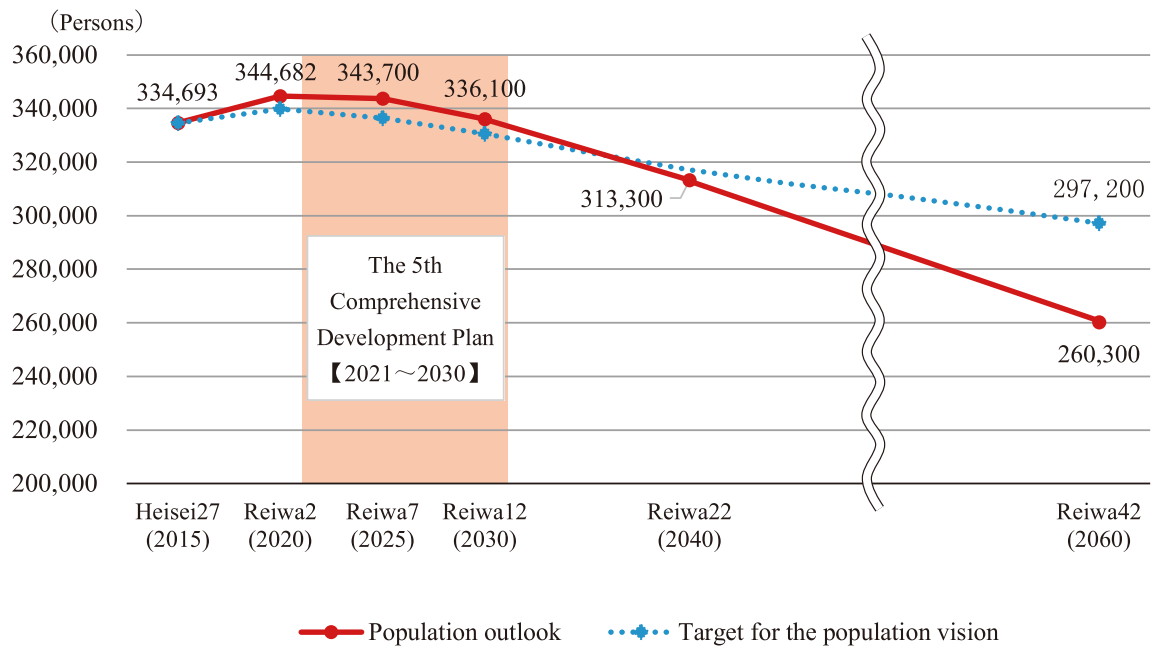


Projected Population

As for the population outlook during this plan's effective period, it is estimated to peak in the year 2022 at about 346,000 people before going into a decline, then drop to about 336,000 people by the year 2030, which is the target year of this plan.

In the long term, the population is estimated to drop to about 260,000 people by the year 2060. However, based on the city's population vision (community, people, and employment creation) in March 2016, it has targeted about 297,000 people in the year 2060.

Concept of the Future Urban Structure

The City regards already promoting train station areas and Nishi-Obukuro district as hubs to conduct refinement of urban infrastructure and balanced land use embracing the uniqueness of each district and promote sustainable city development that can respond to the decreasing population due to a declining birthrate and aging society, climate change, natural disaster, and changes in socioeconomic condition.

Important perspectives for city development are considered as “Promotion Vision” and with this in mind, the City implements each policy. “Promotion Vision” of this plan is following.

City Development from the Perspective of the “New Normal”

Due mainly to climate change, natural disasters occur more frequently bringing severe damages.

An estimate shows that a Tokyo Inland Earthquake which is likely to occur in 70% in the next 30 years may result a casualty of 23,000 people and an economic loss of 95 trillion yen.

In addition, the spread of COVID-19, a new infectious disease that emerged in the year 2019, had a great influence not only on the medical sector but the whole society affecting the social and economic activities. This brought fundamental shifts in various aspects of our lives including the means of communication and ways of working.

In order to cope with those new crises amid the expectation of declining labor force owing to the depopulation mixed with the declining birthrate with aging society, and to create a sustainable and yet distinctive society, a municipality is responsible to implement policies efficiently and effectively. So as the increase in the use of digital technology is widely expected. A municipality needs to adopt new technology and provide public services that are both highly usable and met the various needs of residents in both ordinary and extraordinary times.

Therefore, while preparing for disaster risk and coping with the depopulation and declining birthrate and with aging society, the City promotes information exchange with residents, districts and business owners and as well as the cross-sectional city development which is relevant to the New Normal.

Furthermore, we will promote the working with the latest technologies, rapid information collecting and reporting, and efficient municipal operations by wide area cooperation. City development where everyone continues to stay healthy and lives in harmony (Healthcare, Medical Care, Parenting, Welfare)

The City strives to achieve a city where every resident leads a healthy and peaceful life by supporting one another. We promote a community where every resident including child-rearing families, children, senior residents and persons with disability can live a life helping each other.

Also, to tackle the declining birthrate, the City will create an environment where every child rearing family can raise their children comfortably and achieve a city where children can grow up healthy with dreams and hopes.

In addition, we promote the city where each resident actively promote their health, voluntarily enhance the health promotion measures and live healthy lives with purposes.

To meet the maturing and diversifying needs for health and medical cares, local medical institutions and organizations and the city work together for the refinement of local medical care system and implement preventive measures against infectious diseases for the realization of a community where residents can continue to live peacefully.

In order to build urban structures with centralized and collaborative networks, we promote a systematic city development adapting the feature of the city in harmony with nature and the utilization of train stations. Also we promote the development of a city accessible for everyone by providing a network of traffic roads and public transport.

Also, the City extends the lifespan of public facilities and urban infrastructures such as roads, bridges, parks, and water and sewage pipes, by the revitalization and proper maintenance of existing assets. We also promote the development of a safe and secure urban areas by proper maintenance of local assets such as vacant houses, prevention and suppression of their occurrence, and promotion of their use and marketing as countermeasures against city shrinkage.

Moreover, while promoting a resilient city against natural disasters including typhoons and heavy rains, we also work towards the formation of a high quality urban environment for a thriving city, by adopting the feature of our city, namely the natural environment of water and greenery and local uniqueness and attractiveness.

To pursue an urban city in harmony with nature and to reduce the burden on global environment, we promote a safe and secure livable city that is also environmentally friendly and sustainable by striving on waste reduction and recycling.

To protect every resident's life, health, and possessions from all sorts of crisis such as natural disasters, large-scale terrorist attacks and emerging infectious diseases, the City reinforces the crisis management structure and works on comprehensive and systematic crisis management.

As natural disasters increase in number and severity due to climate change and the like, we will increase the awareness among residents about "protecting one's lives" and reinforce the frameworks of firefighting and disaster prevention.

In addition, the City enhances crime prevention measures and traffic safety measures, and works to address consumer problems in order to realize a city where residents can live safely and securely.

With the geographical advantage of close proximity to the metropolitan area, the City will revitalize commercial and agricultural industries. Also by creating employment opportunities, it will strive to achieve a busy and vibrant city where residents can both work and live.
