During disasters, you may find it difficult to place calls.

Ensure that you know several different ways of contacting family and friends so that if you cannot use one method, you can use a different method without panicking.

# How to Use the Guidebook

## Before a disaster (during normal times)

- ☐ Decide an evacuation area with your family according to the envisaged disaster (earthquake, flood, or large fire).
- ☐ Take disaster preparedness measures such as preparing an emergency bag and securing your furniture so it does not fall over.
- $\square$  Determine a route to the evacuation area.
- ☐ Confirm a place to meet your family and a method to contact them.
- ☐ Decide an evacuation area that you can go to from your workplace or school.
- ☐ Confirm ways to gather information and check well-being.
- ☐ Write down what you have decided as a family ("Methods of contacting family members" on the last page).







## When a disaster has occurred or may occur (during an emergency)

☐ When there is heavy rainfall or an earthquake has occurred, check "Methods of contacting family members" on the back of the front page and refer to "Gathering Information" on pages 12 for information about disasters and evacuation area.





# Take the smartphone app, Avenza Maps, with you!

Avenza Maps is an offline map application that can be used on a smartphone or tablet. There are over 1.5 million maps from around the world registered in the map store and many of them can be downloaded for free. The downloaded maps can tell you your location by using the GPS built into your smartphone even if your device cannot connect to the Internet.


# What if the Tone River Overflows

# This Flood Hazard Map


This map predicts the inundation situation using a simulation in the case that the Tone River overflows due to flooding caused by the maximum amount of predictable rainfall (a once-in-a-thousand-years event: total rainfall of 491 mm over a 72-hour period).

For the city of Koshigaya, should the Tone River overflow, damage and destruction is predicted. This is because the flood plane is larger and the river is deeper than the other areas.

Please check on the map where you live and the height of water in the case that the river overflows.




# Flood hazard map (in the case that the Tone River overflows)

Weather and evacuation information will be announced as per the table below in accordance with the situation.




Note that information may not always be issued in this order.Start evacuating if you feel danger even if information is not issued.

# Tips on evacuation action

Gather information on disaster preparedness and weather, and take the appropriate evacuation action according to the situation.

Sheltering in place at your home or evacuating to **higher floors in a** strong **building** nearby (vertical evacuation) is also an effective evacuation action.



# Time to evacuate! What should you do in that case?

Use a TV, radio, smartphone, and/or other devices to gather the latest information on warnings, weather, and

As a car may get stuck on a flooded road or prevent emergency vehicles from getting through, refrain from evacuating by car if possible.

Evacuate in clothes that enable freedom of movement

Put on comfortable clothes that allow you to move freely when evacuating.

Sandals and boots are not suitable for evacuating, so

Evacuate to a tall building nearby

Evacuate to a strong and tall building nearby or to a higher floor and await rescue.



# Earthquake! What should you do?

If you feel a large amount of shaking, prioritize your own safety. Next, check the situation around you, and if there is danger, head to an evacuation area.

#### If you are in your home



First prioritize your own safety

If you feel shaking intense enough that you cannot stand, get under a strong desk or table. If there is a cushion or some other soft object nearby, use that to protect your head.



2 Take care of open flames

Once the shaking settles down, turn off gas appliances, heaters, and devices with an open flame. Turn off the stop valve for gas appliances and remove the plug from electrical appliances.



6 Ensure an escape exit

Door frames may deform and not open due to the shaking. Open doors and windows in the entrance and rooms to ensure that you can escape at any time.



4 Stay calm and take action

Obtain the correct information from TV and radio, and check disaster information issued by the Koshigaya City government. If your home is in danger, go to an evacuation area.



# Protecting yourself from a tornado

Tornadoes occur suddenly. Learn about the characteristics of tornadoes and take quick action to protect yourself.

#### If you are indoors



- Close shutters and curtains, and move away from windows.
- Get under a desk or table and make yourself Do not go near thick trees or power poles. as small as possible protecting your head.




- Move to a room that does not have windows on the first floor. Hurry into a strong building. If there are no buildings nearby, get into the shadows of the strongest structure as possible and be in a crawling position.

# Items to always have ready

Sheltering at your home that you are familiar with is better than living at an evacuation shelter with people you do not know. It is important to prepare in advance so that you can shelter at your home.








Prepare at least three days worth of food and water, and if possible seven days worth. Generally speaking, one person requires three liters of water per day.

# Things to keep in your home



## Things to take with you when evacuating

If your home is damaged, you will have to live at an evacuation shelter. Aid will take time to arrive. Prepare an emergency kit with the supplies (including medicine) that you need to take with you when evacuating.



# **Gathering information**

If a disaster occurs or there is the risk one may occur, the Koshigaya City government will issue information about evacuation. Evacuation and disaster information can be checked on TV, radio, and the city website, so check how to gather information regularly so that you can check information immediately in the event of a disaster.

# Information that you can check on the disaster preparedness app

- Reception of the emergency broadcast system (a function that receives and reads text aloud)

# **Emergency broadcast**

There are 140 outdoor speakers for the emergency broadcast system installed throughout the city, and evacuation information and other important information is broadcast by the Koshigaya City government during a disaster. Additionally, the content broadcast from the emergency broadcast system can be checked on various media sources.



#### (What is a designated evacuation shelter?)

This is a facility where you can stay temporarily if your home is damaged due to a disaster.

#### What is a designated emergency evacuation area?

This is a place that you can go to escape danger when a disaster occurs or may occur.

## What is a regional evacuation area?

This is a place at which you can protect yourself from radiant heat and smoke from widespread fires caused by a large earthquake.

\*As these evacuation areas and shelters are opened according to the state of damage caused by a disaster, not all evacuation sites are opened at the same time. Check information disseminated by the Koshigaya City government about the open status.


