Important Notes for Vaccination (予防接種を受けるときの注意事項)

What To Bring:
1. Mother and Child Health (MCH) Handbook
2. Pre-vaccination questionnaire
Eligibility: Recipients must reside in Koshigaya City on the date of vaccination. *Those moving out on the day of vaccination are not eligible.
For Those Who Moved in the City
Babies under 9 months old will receive Vaccine Screening Questionnaires and Vouchers for Infant Health Checkups in the month following the transfer.
For babies aged 10 months and older
you can use Pre Vaccination questionnaires available at medical institutions within the city after obtaining Control Number. Apply for the Control Number from the QR code on the right. Application needs to be done at least one week in advance.
*Same process applies to those 9 months old or under who just moved to Koshigaya and wants to get vaccination at once.



If you receive vaccination at Non-designated Medical Institutions Or outside Saitama Prefecture

At a partner institution of Saitama Prefecture’s Mutual Cooperation System for Routine Vaccinations: No Special procedure is required. (Your voucher is valid.)

At non-designated Institutions or at outside Saitama prefecture: Requires prior application for the Vaccination Request Form. Contact **Health Promotion Section (KENKO ZUKURI SUISHIN KA)**

If Parents Cannot Accompany their Child for Vaccination

Child’s relatives who are aged 18 or older can accompany the child as a guardian if they submit a proxy letter.

How to write a Proxy Letter?
Refer to the city website or proxy letter sample attached with pre-vaccination questionnaire forms.

Infants & Toddlers Health Checkups (乳幼児健康診査)

Venue: list of medical Institutions providing vaccinations is on the city website

Note: Contact Children & Families Support Center (**KODOMO KATEI CENTER**) in Municipal Health Center. if you have not received a notification about the checkups even when your child reaches 2 months of age. If you missed the target period, the vaccination will no longer be covered by the public funds.

Target: Aged 19-24 months **Target:** Aged 40-48 months

Venue: Municipal Health Center

Date & Time: You will be notified one month before the scheduled day. To reschedule, apply from the QR code printed on the notification letter. If the child has not undergone the checkup within the designated period, we may contact you.

If the child has already received the checkups in your previous municipality, or done privately, please notify Children & Families Support Center (**KODOMO KATEI CENTER**) in the Municipal Health Center.

5-year-old Checkup

Target: toddlers Born on April 2, 2021 or later
Venue: Municipal Health Center
What’s Included: Medical Interview, body measurement, counseling

Note : A questionnaire will be sent to each eligible child one month before they turn five. Based on the responses to this questionnaire, a checkup notification will be sent only to those who require it

Issuing Mother and Child Health (MCH) Handbook (母子健康手帳)

Pregnant women who are registered citizens of Koshigaya city can receive a Mother and Child Health (MCH) handbook. Apply at the Children and Families Support Center (in City Hall).

Required Documents:

- 1. My Number Card or My Number Notification Card
- 2. Residence Card (or passport)

How to Apply: Mothers are required to attend an in-person interview to receive a handbook. The interview takes approximately 30 minutes.

Note: If you move into Koshigaya City during pregnancy, the prenatal checkup coupons that you received from the previous municipality will no longer be valid and need to be replaced.

Maternity Support Benefit (NINPU SHI'EN KYUFUKIN ・ 妊婦支援給付金)

To lessen the physical, mental and financial burden on prenatal and postnatal women, and to enhance the health and welfare of mothers and their babies, Koshigaya city provides the Maternity Support Benefit.

By providing this benefit along with the Seamless Supportive Consultation Services from Pregnancy through Childbirth and Childcare (NINPU-TO HOKATSU SODAN SHIEN JIGYO), we aim to enhance effective support for expectant and nursing mothers.

Subsidized Maternal Checkups and Newborn Hearing Screenings (妊産婦健康診査、新生児聴覚スクリーニング検査・越谷市妊産婦健康診査等費用助成)

Your coupons are valid at Most maternity clinics within Saitama Prefecture and Designated medical facilities in Tochigi, Ibaraki, Gunma, Chiba, Tokyo and Kanagawa Prefecture. For Details, contact each medical facility or Children and Families Support Center (in City Hall).

If You take the Checkups at Non-designated clinics and had out-of-pocket expenses

You can apply to the city hall for a refund of the checkup fee under the subsidy program AFTER undergoing the checkups/screenings.

Eligibility: Residents of Koshigaya City on the day of the checkup.

Subsidy Amount: Actual costs will be covered, up to a certain limit.

Application Period: Until 1 year after the child's birth

Subsidized 1-Month-Old Checkup (1か月健康診査)

Target: Baby aged 27 days until 6 weeks

Venue: Designated hospitals/clinics in Koshigaya City

Note: A notification is sent out along with a medical questionnaire at 6-7 months pregnancy.
*If you take the checkup at a non-designated hospital/clinic, you can apply to the city for a refund of the checkup fee under the subsidy program AFTER undergoing the checkup.

RS Virus Vaccine (From April 2026~)

Eligibility: Pregnant women residing in Koshigaya City who are between 28 weeks and 36 weeks +6 days of pregnancy

Venue: check the voucher or the city website.

Fee: Free

How to Apply: Contact preferred medical institution to make appointment, bring the Voucher provided with MCH handbook, MCH handbook itself, valid ID (e.g. my number card)

Newborn & Maternal Home Visit (妊産婦・新生児訪問)

Midwives/public health nurses visit families with a newborn once for Body Measurement of newborns / Child-rearing advice and support / Introducing available administrative services...etc.

Target: Mothers with a newborn (under 4 months old) Free of charge

How to Apply: Submit the SHUSSHO RENRAKU HYO (green post card-sized form enclosed within the separate booklet of MCH handbook) to the City Hall, Northern / Southern Branch Office of the city hall at the timing of your submitting birth notification.

Note: Even if you're temporarily outside of Koshigaya City (e.g. at your parents' house after childbirth), you are still eligible if you return within the eligible period. If you wish to request home visit outside Koshigaya city, contact the Child and Families Support Center in the city hall.

Postpartum Midwifery Care (産後支援事業)

Support for physical & mental recovery after childbirth, Breastfeeding guidance (lactation massage etc.), Instructions on how to bathe your baby

Target: Mothers with a newborn under 4 months old

Venue: Designated midwifery clinics (see the table below) or child's home

How to Apply: Contact your preferred midwifery clinic directly.

Items to Bring: Completed application form (SANGO SHI'EN JIGYO RIYO HYO) enclosed in the separate booklet of the MCH handbook, MCH handbook and My-number card and/or Zairyu card.

Fee: Inquire each clinic directly. Up to 1,000 yen will be subsidized once per mother.

“HAGU” Program (産後ケア事業「はぐ」)

Midwives conduct a home visit and/or daycare (daytime or overnight)

Venue: Designated midwifery clinics (see the table below) or child's home

Target: Mothers with a baby aged under 12 months having address in Koshigaya city who need special care and support e.g. Those who cannot receive enough support from their own families / Those who have worries on physical or mental health issues or on child rearing / Those who experienced stillbirth or miscarriage

※Mothers and child who require inpatient treatment or who have infectious diseases cannot receive this Service.

How to Apply: Application can be made from 2 months prior to childbirth. Contact the center at least one month in advance of the day you wish to use the service.
