## History of Koshigaya City

Koshigaya had commercially developed and flourished as the 3rd post town along Nikko-Kaido Road. As called "Riverside Koshigaya", many rivers and irrigations, such as Moto-Arakawa River and Kasai Irrigation Canal, run through the city. Agriculture prospered and mainly rice and vegetables have been growing.

Toward modern times, Tobu Skytree Line was opened in 1899 and the city was modernized. In 1954, 2 towns and 8 villages merged together and became "Koshigaya Town". In the next year, a part of Soka City joined and it became one city as municipality in 1958.

In 1962, Tokyo Metro Hibiya Line was connected to Tobu Skytree Line and it triggered the population to grow greatly. Koshigaya City became the bedroom suburbs of the capital. Later, JR Musashino Line was opened, and the quadruple track railway was completed along Tobu Skytree Line. With the development of infrastructure such as road network, and public facilities such as libraries and community centers, Koshigaya City has been growing as the core city of southeast Saitama.

In 2008, the construction of Koshigaya Laketown was completed around a large reservoir. It is a high quality residential area and has one of the largest shopping malls in Japan. In the next year, Koshigaya City Municipal Ordinance of Autonomy Regulations was enacted and it focused on citizen participation and collaboration, as the norm of city

Currently, based on the 4th Koshigaya City Comprehensive Development Plan which started in 2011, the city has been proceeding to develop communities toward the future vision of city: "safe, secure, and blessed with water and greenery" through citizen participation and collaboration. Koshigaya City celebrates the 60th anniversary of its municipalization in November 2018.

## TRADITIONAL HANDICRAFTS



## Koshigaya Daruma Doll



n the middle of Edo Period, "Koshigaya Daruma" dolls originated from a tumbler doll "Okiagari-Koboshi", on which Bodhidarma sitting in meditation was painted. Koshigaya Daruma has the special features: white skin, long nose and happy fullness body. Recently, Koshigaya Daruma dolls are shipped to all over Japan as memorial goods, good-luck harms, etc. The most part of "Koshigaya Daruma" is handcrafted; its mustache "hige", which is the most important part, is also drawn by hand.

## Koshigaya's Homemade Senbei



The rice cracker "Koshigaya Teyaki Senbei" was sold at a tea house on Oshu-Kaido Road in Edo Period and it gradually became popular as one of Koshigaya's special products. Koshigaya has been famous for producing the nigh-quality rice and called "Rice Granary for Edo"; that is why the tasty "senbei" was produced in Koshigaya. The rice crackers are made by kneading well-examined rice well, brushing them with the producer's specially-made soy sauce on them, and baking one by one.


## Paulownia Box "Koshigaya Kiribako"

In Edo Period, the popular novelist Mr. Sanba Shikitei used the paulownia box "Koshigaya Kiribako" as the container for the lotion "Edo Water" and it gained a good reputation. 
