National Pension Premium Payment Exemption/ Postponement (for July, 2024 – June, 2025)

Who: Those who have difficulty paying pension premium due to decreased income or losing one' job.

Where to apply: National Health Insurance and Pension Section or Pension Office Items to bring for application:

- (1) Something showing one's individual number or Basic Pension Number (2) ID
- *For those who want to apply because of losing one's job, it is required to bring something showing their retirement date.
- *Those who have a My Number Card (individual number card) can apply electronically from Myna Portal.

For Recipients of Child rearing Allowance or **Special Child Rearing Allowance**

Recipients of Child Rearing Allowance (JIDO FUYO TEATE) need to submit a Current Status Report (GENKYO TODOKE) and recipients of Special Child Rearing Allowance (TOKUBETSU JIDO FUYO TEATE) need to submit an Income Status Report (SHOTOKU JYOKYO TODOKE) to the City Office within August.

If you fail to submit, you will not be able to receive the allowance for subsequent months after November, even if you are eligible.

Bank transfer: Tax amount to be paid will be automatically debited from the bank account registered.

Payment apps: Open a payment app or website for municipal taxes payment and Scan

the barcode or two dimensional code on the payament slip.

We would like to introduce one of the Japanese summer festivals, TANABATA.

Do you know "TANABATA"?

TANABATA is a Japanese festival that originally came from China. Now in Japan, on ever July 7th, people write their wishes on TANZAKU which are strips of colored paper and hang them on bamboo branches.

There are many variations of the festival's origin, but one of the most famous ones is the following folk tale;

"Once upon a time, there was a weaver girl named Syo-ku-jyo, who was a daughter of the greatest god in the heaven, Tentei. She married a boy, Kengyu. However, after their marriage, they became idle and the neglected their duties. Tentei was furious about that and separated the two lovers, placing them on opposite sides of a Milky Way. Then they lived in sorrow because of their separation.

In Japan, Syo-ku-jyo is known as Orihime and Kengyu as Hikoboshi.

Orihime is the star Vega in the constellation Lyra and Hikoboshi is the star Altair in the constellation Aquila.

On a dark night, you will see the Milky Way between these two stars.


